

# Mayor's Corner

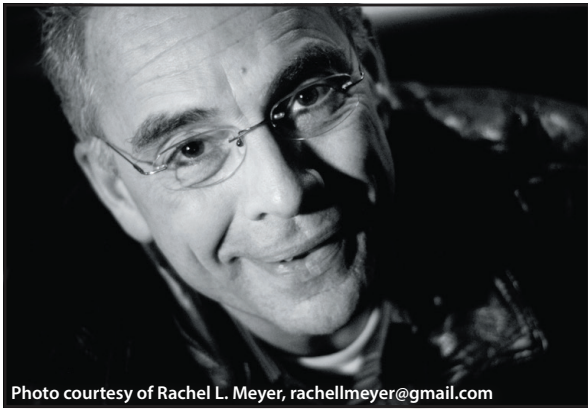
