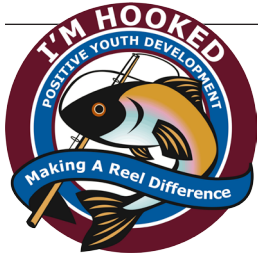


Are you ready to get 'hooked' on fishing?

Nearly 500 children ages 6 to 18 attend this yearly event, which utilizes 25 boats, hundreds of adult supervisors and volunteers.

Children are provided with rods, reels, life vests, snacks and training for the event.

Wil Warren of I'm Hooked, Inc began the non-profit in 1988 as a way to build relationships between adult mentors and children who need them most. The first year included 75 at-risk children from Portland. Following years expanded to include foster children and now the event offers registration to all children.

I'm Hooked, Inc. organizes this year event at the Lake as well as connecting with the right groups. In addition to the non-profit, the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife,
