


# Longtime Tualatin Resident Writes New Book

In April of 1986 longtime Tualatin resident Jeanette Chaffee was on the last leg of her 15 hour flight from Salem to Athens, just a short flight from Rome to Athens, when 40 minutes before landing a bomb hidden underneath seat 10-F was detonated on the aircraft over Argos, Greece. Jeanette was sitting just fourteen feet away from the explosion that blew a 9' x 3' hole in the side of the aircraft, ejecting four American passengers to their death. Seven others on the flight were injured by shrapnel as the cabin suffered a rapid decompression. The remaining 110 passengers miraculously survived the attack as the pilot was able to make a successful landing in Athens.

Understandably, this incident would change Jeanette's life forever. She says, "I believe I survived so that I can emphasize that now's the time for each of us to make peace with God." Jeanette is recognized as a gifted communicator and has appeared on CBS Evening News with Dan Rather, 20/20, The 700 Club, and other television and radio shows. Jeanette has been quoted in USA Today, The New York Times, Newsweek, and has written national magazine articles.

For many years she has told her incredible story and now does author readings of "Terror in the Sky" and has just released her new book, "Extravagant Graces: 23 Inspiring Stories of Facing Impossible Odds."



The book is a compilation of over thirty-five years' worth of Jeanette's personal interviews of some of the most inspiring and influential people of our time, gathering a fantastic collection of intimate testimonials, many of which have been included in her new book, which is now available in stores or online.

Jeanette has lived all over the world and has visited thirty-two countries. She passionately loves adventure and missions. Her work with World Vision inspired her lifelong sponsorship of children.

She graduated from Westmont College, earned an MA in English as a Second Language and taught at the university level. Jeanette loves living in the lush valleys of Oregon's wine country.
